

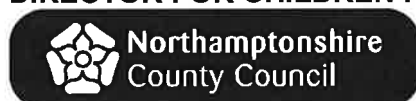
INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT : VOLUNTARY CONTROLLED SCHOOLS

1. The name of the school is **Oundle Church of England Primary School**
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school.
3. The name of the governing body is **“The governing body of Oundle Church of England Primary School”**
4. The Governing Body shall consist of:
 - a) **1** Head Teacher
 - b) **3** parent governors (to be elected)
 - c) **1** staff governor (to be elected)
 - d) **1** Local Authority governor
 - e) **3** foundation governors
 - f) **3** co-opted governors
5. Total number of governors is **12**
6. Foundation governors are appointed and can be removed by Peterborough Diocese Board of Education.
7. Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England, which includes respecting other faiths and in partnership with the church in the parish of St Peter’s Oundle and at diocesan level.

The school aims to serve the community of Oundle by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.
8. This instrument of Government comes into effect on **1 September 2015**
9. This Instrument was made by order of Northamptonshire Local Education Authority on **8 April 2015**
