Names of common toys such as dolls, teddy bears, cars, train, scooter.

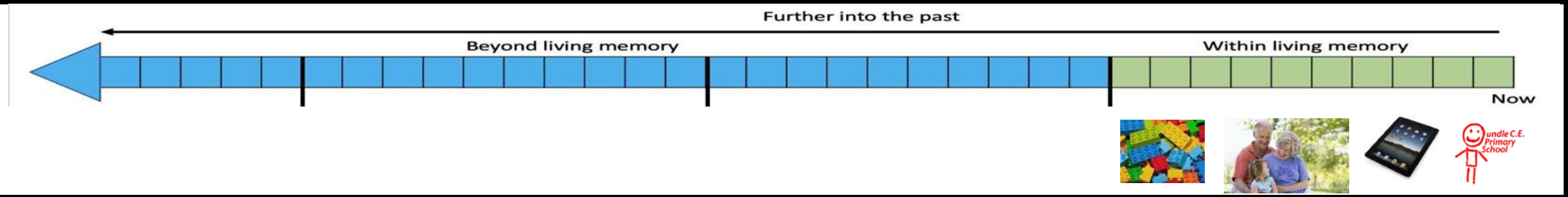
Some games we play on our own, some we play with others.

Then and now

I will sequence up to four generations (me, my parents, my grandparents and my great grandparents) and place them on a timeline.

I am a historian

I know that historian means learning about in the past.

I can find out about the past by asking people for their accounts and knowledge.

I can find out about the past by looking at and handling items from the past.

I can say what is similar and what is different when comparing toys.

I can sequence two objects into then/ now/ older/ newer.

I know that that life now is different from the past and that many things we have now (plastics/electricity) did not exist in the past.
