<p><u>ENGLISH (ongoing)</u></p> <p>Practise spellings. Spellings are now on Purple Mash, children will need to do look, write, cover, check on paper and then complete the quiz on Purple Mash. Children will be quizzed during the week. We will send the list home on a Friday.</p> <p>Reading - Children are expected to read to an adult at least 3 times a week (5 is preferable).</p>	✓	
<p><u>MATHS (ongoing)</u></p> <p>Login to TTRS (Times Table Rock Stars) with your personal login details (to be found at the back of your school diary).</p> <p>KIRFs (Key Instant Recall Facts) to practice over the term. Children to show that they have practiced by showing their learning by sending a picture on Dojo. Children will be tested on these twice a term (Week 3 and 6).</p>	✓	
<p><u>CHANGE 4 LIFE</u></p> <p>Go for a walk with your family. Can you find as many different trees as you can and name them? (Maybe make a booklet with a picture of the tree with its name). Or maybe go bird watching in your garden or on a walk? What birds can you name and find? (How could you present what you saw?)</p>		✓
<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Within our topic we will be learning about volcanoes and earthquakes. We would like you to design and make a creative piece of artwork on a volcano of your choice. It could be a painting, sculpture, drawing, collage or any other creative ideas!</p>		✓
